Allman College encourages all its students to enrol online with the State Library of NSW so that they can access a full research library, including a range of data bases to support their learning.

The State Library of New South Wales, part of which is known as the Mitchell Library, is a large heritage-listed special collections, reference and research library open to the public. It is the oldest library in Australia, being the first established in New South Wales in 1826



Library cards are free of charge. Students can sign up for a Library Card [online](#) or when Students are at the Library.

With a Library card Students can:

- use most of the Library's collections
- access e-resources in the Library
- use most of the e-resources including ebooks from anywhere (NSW residents only)
- request books from other libraries
- print and photocopy
- use library computers
- book a study room.

The library's Proquest and EBSCO databases cover business, management, HR, marketing, finances, accounting, health, ageing and community services.

The databases are all online and are quick and easy to use. Students can also consult online with a librarian if they need any help in finding information.
